Interested applicants are required to strictly observe steps outlined below to secure an appointment.

- Scan all requirements as listed on the website <http://philippineembassy-usa.org/philippines-dc/consular-services-dc/> and email to outreach@phembassy-us.org.
- In the subject, indicate MIAMI OUTREACH
- Send payment in money order or cashier’s check payable to the “Philippine Embassy” by mail (Consular Section, Philippine Embassy, 1617 Massachusetts Ave., NW, Washington DC 20036) **individually or by group.**
- Schedule of fees:

• Passport (First time and Renewal)	\$ 60.00
• Lost Passport	\$ 150.00
- Include brief cover letter indicating:
 - Name/s of Applicant/s
 - Contact Email and Number
 - Type of Service (i.e, renewal, 1st time applicant, lost passport)
 - Outreach Site: Miami
 - Amount Sent:

Deadline for receipt of mailed payment and email scans: [19 January 2018](#)

- Wait for Embassy email confirmation with date and time of appointment.

- Come to the outreach site 20 minutes prior to the approved appointment schedule with original documents and prepaid return priority or priority express mail envelope (with requisite stamps and tracking number).

- Wait for the approved application:
 - Passport: (renewal and 1st time) 6-8 weeks from application
 - Expired Lost passport : 8-12 weeks from application
 - Valid Lost passport: 15-day waiting period, on top of the 8- to 12-week processing period, and if the passport was not issued by the Philippine Embassy in WDC.
